**RECOMMENDATION TO THE
STATE PERSONNEL BOARD**


On or about September 19, 2018, counsel for Appellant filed a “Motion to Withdraw” and “Request for Continuance.” On September 20, 2018, the undersigned GRANTED the “Motion to Withdraw” based upon the grounds stated in the motion.

On September 20, 2018, Appellant was contacted by telephone by the undersigned’s staff and asked whether he was available for a conference call on September 21, 2018. Appellant stated he was at work and could not speak on the telephone and that he would not be available on September 21 for a conference call. However, Appellant requested that his number be called again and that a voice mail message be left with details. Appellant was left a message on September 20, 2018, asking that he place a return call and leave a message indicating whether he wanted

a continuance in the matter to provide him an opportunity to retain another attorney or if he would like to go forward *pro se* with the hearing set for September 28, 2018. Appellant failed to respond. Thereafter, Appellant was ORDERED to notify the undersigned, in writing, by close of business on October 5, 2018, whether he intended to pursue his appeal. Appellant was warned, **“Failure to comply with this order will result in this case being recommended for dismissal.”** Appellant failed to respond.

Wherefore premises considered, it is the recommendation of the undersigned that the appeal should be DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE for failure to prosecute.

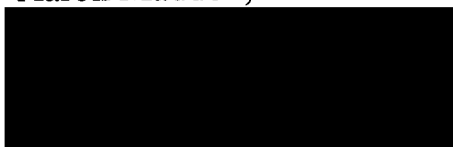
