ORDER

July 20, 2016

This matter came before the Board upon the dismissal of the Employee from his employment with the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency ("ALEA"). This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") James Jerry Wood, as Hearing Officer for the State Personnel Board. On June 21, 2016, the ALJ received a Motion to Dismiss from ALEA. The Motion to Dismiss cited as grounds the resignation it received from Employee. The Employee was provided a copy of the Motion to Dismiss by electronic mail at his E-mail address of record on June 21, 2016, and has not objected thereto. Based upon the Employee's resignation, the ALJ recommended the appeal be dismissed with prejudice.

The Board has carefully considered the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order and is of the opinion that the appeal should be dismissed with prejudice.


It is therefore the Order of this Board that the decision to dismiss the appeal is hereby affirmed.




