

**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND JOINT MOTION FOR
DISMISSAL OF APPEAL WITH PREJUDICE**

COMES NOW, the Alabama Department of Corrections (“ADOC”), and Levar Dixon, and hereby reach the following agreement concerning the recommended termination of Appellant effective on or about December 15, 2025. As grounds therefore, the parties state as follows:

1. Appellant Levar Dixon was employed by ADOC beginning on or about March 16, 2009.
2. After a Pre-dismissal Conference, ADOC recommended that Mr. Dixon be terminated as of December 15, 2025.
3. On or about December 29, 2025, Mr. Dixon appealed his termination to the State of Alabama Personnel Department.
4. The parties now wish to enter into an agreement resolving this employment matter. It is hereby agreed to by the parties as follows:
 - a. That the separation of Levar Dixon, effective December 15, 2025, shall be notated as a resignation, in good standing.


- b. ADOC agrees to mark him as a “yes” for rehire for other State agencies.
- c. Mr. Dixon understands that ADOC will mark him as a “no” to reemployment with ADOC.
5. Mr. Dixon agrees to release all claims for any damages or other relief of any kind related to his employment with ADOC, whether know or unknown, whether foreseen or unforeseen, and whether patent or latent, which he may have now against ADOC. This release of all claims for any damages or other relief in connection with the Agreement extends to the State of Alabama, its departments and/or agencies, its agents, employees, officers, directors, and servants.
6. This agreement shall become effective upon the affixing of the signatures of the parties and their representatives and the approval of the State Personnel Department.




