
This matter came before the Board upon the dismissal of the Employee from his employment with the Department of Corrections. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Randy C. Sallé.

On March 11, 2019, the Employee filed an employee dismissal appeal. The Employee was sent a letter on March 18, 2019, stating the date, time, and location for a pre-hearing conference. The letter stated: “Failure to appear for the Prehearing Conference or provide a telephone number at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance may result in dismissal of the appeal.” On March 26, 2019, the prehearing conference was held. The Employee failed to appear at the prehearing conference and failed to notify the ALJ’s office of his intent to participate in the prehearing conference by telephone. On March 26, 2019, the Employee was Ordered to notify the ALJ, in writing, by April 9, 2019, of his intent to pursue his appeal. The Order stated, “Failure to comply with this Order will result in this case being recommended for dismissal.” The Employee failed to respond to the Order. Accordingly, this case is recommended for dismissal.

It is therefore the Order of this Board that the case be DISMISSED WITH
PREJUDICE for failure to prosecute.


